## *Medical Mission*

Based on the Hospital motto “love your neighbor as yourself”, Missionary Department of Puli Christian Hospital mainly provides services of spiritual care to patients, family members, friends and staff members at the Hospital. In God’s love, the Department aims to be a part of the holistic care by means of presenting Christian faith and giving supports.

In addition to spiritual care, chaplains of the Department also give emotional support and listen to patients with openness and understanding. Patients, families and staffs are encouraged to call a chaplain when experiencing fear, anger, loneliness, helplessness, anxiety, grief or loss, or simply when they need someone to talk to. Chaplains also help to find out the needs of disadvantaged patients and families through regular visiting. They help to report to social workers for possible welfare resources and apply or purpose a fundraising plan for the disadvantaged.

In our overseas mission, the Department also cares and supports churches in Burkina Faso of the West Africa.

To support our works on medical mission, there are fundraising projects as follows.
